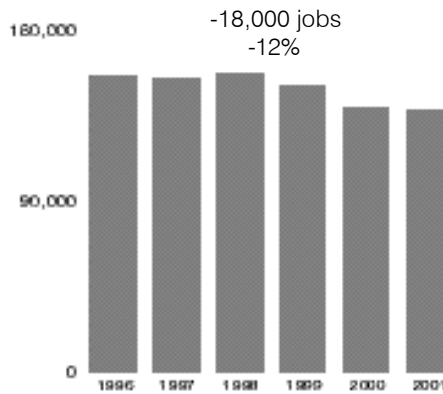

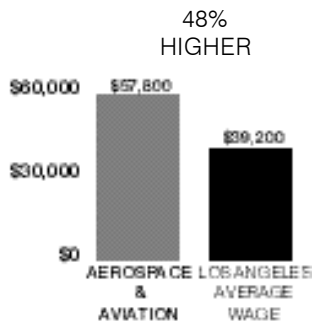
EMPLOYMENT 1996 - 2001
